Deadline: 5:00 pm on December 2, 2024

Students who need to remain in University housing for special reasons may receive priority over other returning students by applying for priority in the housing draw through the Hardship Housing process. You must be readmitted to and be enrolled in the 2025-2026 academic year to receive hardship housing.

If you need a specific medical accommodation, you will also need to go through the Office of Disability Services' Medical Accommodation Process. Approval for hardship housing does not guarantee a particular unit type or other preferences.

Students applying for Hardship Housing need to SUBMIT the following information:

1. This completed application form
2. A statement explaining your situation (financial or personal)
3. A copy of your most recent Federal Income Tax Return
4. Complete the Room Draw Application (when application opens)
